OLD BUSINESS:

1. Discussion of a 425 Agreement with Paradise Township for the purpose of providing water and sewer services for the Kingsley Club; draft a schedule to approve the 425 Agreement and provide initial terms of 425 Agreement to Paradise Township for their review.

Village Council discussed a number of non-negotiable items including: length of agreement 50 years for the purpose of providing the development with Village sewer and water service; subject to Village and Township taxation, but there will be no sharing of revenues; the Village will retain all sewer and water connection and services rates, charges, and fees, as well as any Village taxes levied on the property; the Township will retain any revenues derived from the levy of Township taxes on the property; property will be considered part of the Township for all other purposes and services; at the conclusion of the agreement (in 50 years), the property will be permanently transferred to the Village. Two negotiables were discussed and the Village Manager has been directed to share them with the Village's attorney.

Motion by Weger, seconded by McPherson, to direct Village Manager Aldrich to present the 425 Agreement with the language discussed to Paradise Township with the dates outlined for response.
